

Chip Flip Clip is a new game using two sets of either the standard chips or the Board game chips. It is important that each player has chips that are distinguishably theirs. (This is typically a two player game, but if more unique sets are available, more than two people can play.)

Rules:

1. Each player has a standard set of Chip Flips; removing the chips that have the number 10. Typically, leaving each player with 15 chips.
2. Determine which player goes first.
3. The first player chooses any chip in their pile and flips it. The number that lands face up determines where to place it on the "Chip Flip Clip" board.
4. The next player chooses any chip in their pile and flips it. The number that lands face up determines where to place it on the board. If a chip is already on that space, place it on top of that chip.
5. Play continues alternating between each player until there is a winner.
6. The player with three of their chips "viewable" in a row wins the game.
7. If each player runs out of chips, the game ends in a tie.
